Required: Reporting of critical incidents on or before November 30, 2017

Although AmeriHealth Caritas Iowa will no longer be participating in the IA Health Link program starting December 1, 2017, **providers are still required** to send us reports of critical incidents that happened on or before November 30, 2017. The requirement to send critical incident reports is outlined in Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 441, Chapters 77 and 90.

If you need to submit a critical incident report to AmeriHealth Caritas Iowa, please keep these things in mind:

- The <u>Iowa Medicaid Critical Incident Report</u> is located on our website in the <u>Forms</u> section, then <u>Quality Management</u>.
- Please submit your completed critical incident reports to AmeriHealth Caritas Iowa at
 <u>ACIACriticalIncidentReporting@amerihealthcaritas.com</u>. You can also use this email if you
 have questions about filling out the <u>Iowa Medicaid Critical Incident Report.</u>
- You are required to use the revised <u>lowa Medicaid Critical Incident Report</u>, effective January 1, 2017. Previous versions will not be accepted.
- Fax submission of critical incident reports is no longer an option.

Critical incident reporting at AmeriHealth Caritas Iowa

Critical incident reporting, as described in <u>IAC Chapters 77 and 90</u>, is a requirement for those eligible to participate in home and community-based services (HCBS). When a major incident has been witnessed or discovered, the HCBS provider/case manager must complete the <u>lowa Medicaid Critical Incident Report</u> and submit it to AmeriHealth Caritas lowa with as much information as possible regarding the incident.
